FINAL TICKET RELEASE FOR COMMBANK MATILDAS 'TIL IT'S DONE FAREWELL SERIES IN ADELAIDE AND SYDNEY

In response to high demand, Football Australia, in collaboration with the South Australian and New South Wales Governments, is thrilled to announce a final limited ticket release for the CommBank Matildas' *'Til It's Done Farewell* Series against China PR.

A limited number of tickets will go on sale for each match at 2.00pm (local) on Monday, 29 April 2024 via Ticketek.

Australia will play the AFC Women's Asian Cup India 2022[™] winning *Steel Roses* on Friday, 31 May 2024 (7.40pm ACST) at Adelaide Oval before playing their last match on home soil prior to Paris on Monday, 3 June 2024 (7:40pm AEST) at Accor Stadium in Sydney.
